Case Study #2 – Getting Tough on Pharmacy Costs

- Maxor Correctional Pharmacy helped a state system with more than 20,000 inmate patients realize more than \$2.7 million in cost avoidance in just nine months. The state achieved these savings through more effective medication utilization and implementing therapeutic substitutions recommended by the Maxor clinical services team.
- A smaller, county-level jurisdiction of approximately 1800 inmate patients decreased overall pharmacy expenditures by 48% over three months by implementing targeted formulary management tools such as therapeutic interchange programs and correction's specific disease treatment protocols.
